FALL LEAF COLLECTION



Collection will begin in late October and continue until December.
Leaves must be raked between the sidewalk and curb. Absolutely no leaves will be pick-up curbside after the last scheduled collection day in December. Leaves shall then be disposed in the regular scheduled yard waste collection. (Please follow the requirements for yard waste disposal when disposing of the leaves at the conclusion of the fall collection, refer to our collection calendar for specific start and end dates) Please call the DPW for more info 856-783-4648

The leaf machine will systematically go through the town. We will check every street for leaf piles, once your street has been checked the machine WILL NOT return until every other street in town has been cleared of leaves. The machine will return within approximately 7 to 10 days, sometimes quicker, depending on the weather and quantity of leaves on every other street.

Please follow these rules when raking leaves to the curb for collection...

All leaf piles <u>MUST BE REACHABLE</u>
<u>WITH THE LEAF MACHINE SUCTION</u>
<u>HOSE</u>, if piles are at a dead end or in a cul-de-sac, the leaves <u>MUST</u> be placed where the hose of the machine can reach the pile of leaves.

WE WILL NOT BACK THE MACHINE OFF THE ROADWAY INTO A DRIVEWAY OR INTO A PARKING LOT.

Please do not place leaves close to basketball backboards, telephone poles, mailboxes, etc. located along the curb line, the borough will not be responsible for any damage to these items if leaves are piled around them, AND, it may result in the pile not being collected.

- Rake pile between sidewalk and curb, NOT in the roadway
- Do not park on, near, or in front of a pile
- Rake pile into long narrow strip, not into a mounded pile
- > DO NOT cover storm inlets, keep 10-feet away
- > ONLY LEAVES ARE ACCEPTED, NO TRASH, STICKS, BRANCHES, PLANTS, BRICKS, PET WASTE, WOOD, VINES, LOGS, OR ANY OTHER DEBRIS!

STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT NO LEAVES BE PLACED WITHIN 10-FEET OF A STORM INLET



Please remember, raking leaves loose to the curb-line for collection is more cost effective for our community. Compared to bagging leave and placing them in the yard waste collection. So please rake your leaves to the curb-line during the designated collection days in Spring and Fall!!
